4) President Report

4.1) Prof Ismail once again reminded all AOASO member countries to provide update regarding their Association/Society activities so that the website <u>www.aoaso.org</u> can provide latest information of their respective Association/Society, in particular, the current address of the new President and Secretary of their Association.

4.2) Prof Ismail attended the World Obesity Roundtable 2018: *Obesity on the Agenda: Ending the Global Obesity Epidemic*", 10, James Square, London, 11 April 2018 as an Invited Speaker.

4.3) ICO 2022 in the Asia-Pacific Region

Prof Ismail met the WOF executives on 10TH April 2018 to have an informal discussion the subject of hosting ICO 2022 in the Asia-Pacific region. WOF will send letters/proposal to all AOASO country member's well in advance for ICO 2022. The MOU and selection criteria to organize ICO will be jointly prepared by Prof. Anna Peters AOASO – ICO representative and the bidding for ICO 2022 will take place during 10th AOCO in Seoul – Korea in Sept 2019.

4.4) 11th AOCO 2021

AOASO have organized the AOCO series biennially since 2001. The 11th AOCO is scheduled in 2021 and the bidding will take place during 10th AOCO 2019 in Seoul, Korea. Member countries keen in hosting the event are requested to submit an "Expression of Interest" letter to the President AOASO

4.5) AOASO participation in UIA 2018

Prof Ismail will represent AOASO in 6th.Union of International Association (UIA) Round Table Asia-Pacific 2017 to be held on 26-27 September 2018 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. The UIA Round Table Series provide an opportunity to its members to learn through networking and practices, to meet other international associations and share experience and knowledge to help run their organization better. One of the key objective of the RT was to bring together all Organizations (non -medical and medical and health sciences) to meet up with national Convention Bureau in their respective countries to collaborate and host future international events.

4.6) As this meeting marks the end of my term as President and Dr Pallavi as the Secretary of AOASO (2014-2018), we would like to express our sincere thanks to AOASO member countries for their support during our term of office and it's our fervent hope that the new Council will be given similar if not better support to ensure AOASO remain relevant to serve the Asian community at large.
