




Which long-term AOMs have been approved in your country? 11 responses




Which long-term AOMs are currently available and being supplied in your country? 11 responses




Is there any reimbursement available for obesity pharmacotherapy in your country?





Is the supply of orlistat stable in your country?




What is the usual cost of orlistat 120 mg taken three times a day for 28 days in USD? 11 responses
























